

## „GERMANY IS KNOWN FOR THE QUALITY OF ITS EDUCATION“

*The aims the 1000th Haniel scholar sets herself*

The Haniel Stiftung awarded its 1000th scholarship, just in time for the 20th anniversary of its founding. It was awarded to Olha Narolska from Lviv (Lemberg) in the Ukraine. She took part in the Go West programme and in the autumn she began her Master's degree at the Erfurt School of Public Policy. We asked the 21-year-old three questions:

### *Why did you choose a course in Germany?*

„In the Ukraine I studied 'International Relations'. I specialised in the European Union. I graduated with a Bachelor's after eight semesters. It was important for me to study in an EU country for the Master's so I could gain more knowledge from first-hand experience. And Germany is well known for the quality of its education.“

### *What are the advantages of studying for a Master of Public Policy in Erfurt?*

“The MPP course at Erfurt Uni combines very good theoretical and practical methods of learning in exactly those subjects that I find most interesting. The number of students from various nationalities enables me to get to know and understand the views of other countries.“



*What do you expect from the course at the ESPP – also for your future career?*

“I would like to improve my knowledge of the political functions of the European Union and other international systems. Additionally, I will try to get some work experience through an internship in the summer of 2009. Hopefully in an institution of the EU or an international organisation where many different nations are represented, for example at the United Nations. This is also the area in which I would like to work in the future in order to represent my country of origin at international level.” ||
